Dr. Sudhi Ranjan Garg is Professor of Veterinary Public Health and took over as Head of Department in the College of Veterinary Sciences, Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University at Hisar in India in November 2006. He graduated from this institution in the year 1979. Based on a national examination, he was awarded Junior Research Fellowship by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research to pursue postgraduate studies. Dr. Garg received the degree of Master of Veterinary Sciences in Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology in the year 1982. Later, he was awarded Russian Government Scholarship for doctoral studies. He obtained doctorate from the Kovalenko All-Russian Institute of Experimental Veterinary Medicine in Moscow in the year 1991. He has been elected Fellow of the Indian Association of Veterinary Public Health Specialists.

Dr. Garg began his career as Assistant Professor, Veterinary Public Health in the year 1982. He was subsequently promoted as Associate Professor and later as Professor in the year 2003. He has a vast experience of undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and research. He has guided many postgraduate research students for the award of Master of Veterinary Sciences and Ph.D. degrees. The areas of his major research include foodborne pathogens and epidemiology of zoonotic diseases. He has contributed numerous scientific publications. He has authored a book “Understanding Rabies and its Prevention”. He has edited another book “Interdisciplinary Approach for Tuberculosis Control”.

Dr. Garg has worked in several academic, professional and administrative bodies. He is a Life Member of the Indian Association of Veterinary Public Health Specialists; Indian Association of

Veterinary Microbiologists, Immunologists and Specialists in Infectious Diseases; and Association of Food Scientists & Technologists of India. Dr. Garg has attended a number of national and international scientific conferences, workshops and trainings and has widely traveled in India and abroad.

Dr. Garg has organized many programmes to raise public awareness of the prevention and control of zoonotic diseases. These include a Symposium on Interdisciplinary Approach for Tuberculosis Control on the occasion of the World TB Day; Rabies Awareness Campaign for School Children, Workshop on Rabies and its Prevention, and Rabies Awareness Rally on the occasion of the Inaugural World Rabies Day; and Public Awareness Campaigns on the occasion of the World Zoonoses Day and the second World Rabies Day. He has plans to further strengthen these activities for the benefit of the society.
